Hot Lunch Orders

It is imperative that you get your child's hot lunch order in by the due date! The hot lunch chairs need to have an accurate count when they place the order. They are receiving orders 1 and 2 weeks after the orders are placed with the vendor. In some cases that is too late. That puts the chairperson in a difficult position. Then on that lunch day, someone (frequently a teacher) gives up their hot lunch for your child. **To rectify this, from this point forward, if your order is not received by the due date, it will be returned to you. Your child will not receive that hot lunch for that order period.** We do not want to take this aggressive position, but this problem is growing (again) and it needs to be corrected. Please help us by getting your order in on time. Remember the chair people are volunteer parents doing the best they can, please help them do their job.
