## Dear Parish and School Leaders.

In this time when we seem to have caught up on the various issues requiring immediate guidance/response, please see below for a listing of a number of updates re: the Church's response to COVID-19 and efforts by the Archbishop to communicate this Holy Week:

- 1) The Archbishop's Easter Sunday Mass from Cathedral of Mary Our Queen will air live at 12Noon on WBAL-TV, Ch. 11, in addition to being livestreamed on the web. The Masses of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Vigil will be livestreamed only. - 2) WBAL-TV will do two live interviews via Skype with Msgr. Rick Hilgartner on Easter morning, at 7:15 a.m. and 9:15 a.m.
- 3) WJZ-TV is scheduled to film a segment Thursday on the impact of the COVID-19 virus on funerals and will interview Fr. Patrick Carrion about the challenges posed to families and to priests. Having recently lost his own brother, Father Carrion will offer a unique perspective from both viewpoints.
- 4) The Baltimore Sun is interviewing priest-chaplains about the Sacrament of the Sick and the specific challenges of anointing a patient who is dying of COVID-19. We are working with them to offer priests to speak about this topic, which was the subject of a recent reflection by Father Larry Johnson.
- 5) Tomorrow, Archbishop Lori will bless University of Maryland Medical Center, Bishop Madden will bless Johns Hopkins Hospital and Bishop Parker will bless Mercy Medical Center—all at 11 a.m. as a demonstration of prayer and support for those who are caring for the sick and for all who are patients in our healthcare facilities.
- 6) Today, Archbishop Lori was interviewed by WBAL-AM, WBAL-TV, WJZ-TV, The Catholic Review and Crux about the challenges the Church is facing this Holy Week and how parishes are working to bring the Church to the people.
