Thank you for your patience, understanding and prayers as we navigate through this uncertain time in all of our lives. We will be taking the following steps as an institution to provide continuing education to our students.

Step 1: All students are coming home today with all of their books and materials needed to complete work for the next two weeks.

Step 2: Please check all of your child(ren)'s teacher's websites daily to ensure that you have the most up to date assignments that are to be completed. (This includes special areas.)

Step 3: Students that said that they did not have access to technology were allowed to borrow a chrome book. The chrome book and charger are to be returned on the first day we return back to school. Students are reminded that this is school property and needs to be used according to our acceptable use policy. Students and families are responsible for the cost if lost or damaged up to \$400.

Step 4: If your child was absent from school today, their books and materials will be available on Monday, March 16^{th} at the main entrance from 8 - 12.
