**-\$10 to park, decorate and distribute your own purchased goodies OR**

**-\$15 to PARK ONLY and Trunk or Treat (includes fee for one child) plus \$5 for each additional child**

## RULES

-This event is family friendly, so no alcohol is permitted.

-All cars must purchase a ticket in advance. No tickets will be sold at the event! Every car must have a ticket/admission slip.

-We will not save spaces. First come first serve. If you wish to park next to a friend please arrive with that person driving in front of or behind you.

-Cars must be turned off during the event.

-Parking:

**Decorators:** the parking lots will open at 6:15 pm

**Parkers:** the back parking lot will open at 7:00. If you arrive early, please stay in your vehicle until 7:15.

Trunk or Treat starts at 7:30 pm. All lots will be closed until 9:00 pm. No cars will be permitted to enter/leave/drive from all lots until the event is over at 9:00pm

-There will be no electricity provided; you can bring a generator if you need it for lights/ decorations.

-Please keep all décor and costumes kid friendly; no gory or “adult” themes or costumes.

-No animals allowed. No open flames.

-To keep your cost down and sugar levels at a minimum please bring one - two pieces of candy per child to distribute. ALL TREATS SHOULD BE STORE BOUGHT AND INDIVIDUALLY WRAPPED. NO HOMEMADE TREATS!! We will provide a head count prior to the event based on tickets purchased so you know how much candy to bring. For those of you decorating we will distribute extra candy to you upon entry to the parking lot to help offset some of the cost of candy distribution.

-IF YOU HAVE SELECTED TO HAVE A PEANUT FREE CAR PLEASE LET US KNOW UPON ENTRY TO THE PARKING LOT. We will send you a teal pumpkin to display when you receive your ticket.

-Tickets will be sent home with your child through school (will be color coded according to whether or not you are decorating). Please try to remember this the day of the event. If however you forget we will have a list of the paid childrens’ names as you enter and are checked in.
