Parking Lot Reminders

- All lines in the parking lot for dismissal should be straight so the lot can be filled in an organized manner. This will help with the flow of leaving campus as well.
- In order for our dismissal schedule to stay prompt, parents with only Kindergarteners should exit campus immediately after getting their children.
- No children should be playing in the parking lot, on the hill, or by the statue of St. Joseph, as this can be dangerous.
