BOOST - Broadening Options & Opportunities for Students

The state of Maryland enacted the BOOST Scholarship Program in 2016 to give K-12 students from lower-income families an opportunity to find the best educational fit for their needs by awarding applicants with scholarships to attend a nonpublic school. If you are a current BOOST family, please remember that you must fill out the application each year to renew your scholarship. BOOST recipients and their siblings are prioritized by the State. 
