Health Suite Paperwork

- 1. <u>Current Immunization records</u> up to date from the child's physician
 - *Students entering Kindergarten proof of #2 MMR/#2 Varicella is required, State Law
- **2.** Health Inventory/Physical Examination completed by physician for current year, State Law * For all students , Maryland Schools Record of Physical Examination

- 3. *** For students age 4 or 5 years ONLY***, All About Me form (OCC 8506), Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Blood Lead Testing form (DHMH form 4620), and an Emergency Form (OCC 1214).
- **4. Dental form** completed by child's Dentist
- **5.** <u>Medication order forms</u> if needed or required (see Parent/Student Handbook)
 - ~ <u>Over the Counter Medication Order</u> form (<u>**Must**</u> be signed by both parent and provider)
 - ~ <u>Maryland State Medication Authorization Form</u> (prescription medication form <u>must</u> be signed by both parent and provider)
 - ~ <u>Food Allergy Action Plan</u> (<u>Must</u> be completed by provider)

***All medications must be hand delivered to Nurse by an adult, not given to student to transport

- Wine Crewneck Cardigan Sweater w/SJS logo or SJS-logo P.E. Sweatshirt
- Full-length White Socks (above the ankle) or White or Wine Full Length Knee-High Socks
- White or Wine Tights

Girl Uniform Accessories



- ~ White or Burgundy Knee-High Socks
- ~ White Crew Socks NO ANKLE SOCKS!
- ~ White or Burgundy Tights
- ~ Plain black Mary Jane shoes
- ~ SJS Girls Sweater or PE Sweatshirt
- ~ All hair accessories must white, gray, burgundy, or black
- ~ Hair should be natural color
- ~ Jumper plaid headband or scrunchie
- ~ No writing on headband unless SJS
- ~ No rings, bracelets, hoop or dangling earnings, or necklaces. One religious necklace is permitted.
- ~ Undershirts should be white or nude colored
- ~ Small tight shorts should be worn under jumpers

The "Regular" Uniform

- Gray pants with black belt (*Kindergarten does not require a belt and can wear elastic-waist version)
- White knit polo (long or short-sleeve) with SJS logo or white turtleneck with SJS logo
- Wine V-Neck Cardigan Sweater w/SJS logo or SJS-logo P.E. Sweatshirt
- Full-length white or black socks
- Black leather or nubuck dress shoes

"Warm Weather" Option


- Flynn O'Hara khaki shorts (*Only Kindergarten may wear elastic-waisted shorts. 1st-5th require a belt with shorts)



Gray Uniform Pants White SJS Polo Black Shoes All Year






Kindergarten may have the elastic waist pants and shorts




Boy Accessories

- ~ White Crew Socks with shorts NO ANKLE SOCKS!
- ~ White, Black or Gray crew socks with pants
- ~ SJS Boys Sweater or PE Sweatshirt
- ~ No belt's for Kindergarten!
- ~ All haircuts must be above the ear, eyebrows, and collar
- ~ Hair should be cut the same length all around
- ~ Hair should be natural color
- ~ No rings, bracelets, earrings, or necklaces. One religious necklace is permitted.
- ~ Undershirts should be white or nude colored
- ~ Plain black dress shoe tie shoe preferred











PE Uniforms



- ~ PE gray t-shirt should always be worn
- ~ Burgundy PE shorts worn from Ist day until early Nov. and mid April to last day
- ~ PE sweatshirt and sweatpants when colder
- ~ PE sweatshirt is required during cold months
- ~ White Crew Socks NO ANKLE SOCKS!
- ~ Sneakers with laces or Velcro
- ~ NO SLIP-ON SNEAKERS
- ~ NO LIGHT UP SNEAKERS







Cindergarten Fees include their bencil box, pencil box supplies, HFW card box, homework binders, and rest mats. The school will purchase these items.





Kindergarten School Supplies 2025/2026

- ·I backpack <u>large</u> enough to fit folder, homework binder, lunch box and snack. NO BACKPACKS WITH WHEELS PLEASE!
- · I lunch box marked with name
- I kitchen towel to put on table under lunch food (this towel gets sent daily in lunchbox—do not send with supplies!)
- · I snack box or bag marked with name
- · I old, large t-shirt for a smock for art with name on it no towel or store bought plastic smocks, just an old adult t-shirt
- · I box of tissues NO lotion tissues
- · 5 containers of Wet Ones anti-bacterial hand wipes
- · I black expo marker thin
- · I ream of white paper

Please label the backpack, lunch box, snack bag, and art smock with your child's name. It may be necessary to replenish supplies later in the year. We may also request additional items needed for special projects or occasions throughout the year.

VIRTUS

- ~ Go to www.virtusonline.org
- ~ Set up your account
- ~ This includes a background check and listing information for 3 references
- ~ Do not stop in the middle of this process. You will not be able to go back and finish
- ~ Once you have set up the account, entered the information for the background check, and your references, you will be prompted to do the online training
- ~ Once you get to this point you can stop and come back to the training.
- ~ The whole process should take 45-60 minutes
- ~ Please don't wait to do this, DO IT NOW!
- ~ The background check can take weeks to come back. Your 3 references must respond.
- ~ Certification is good for 5 years.
