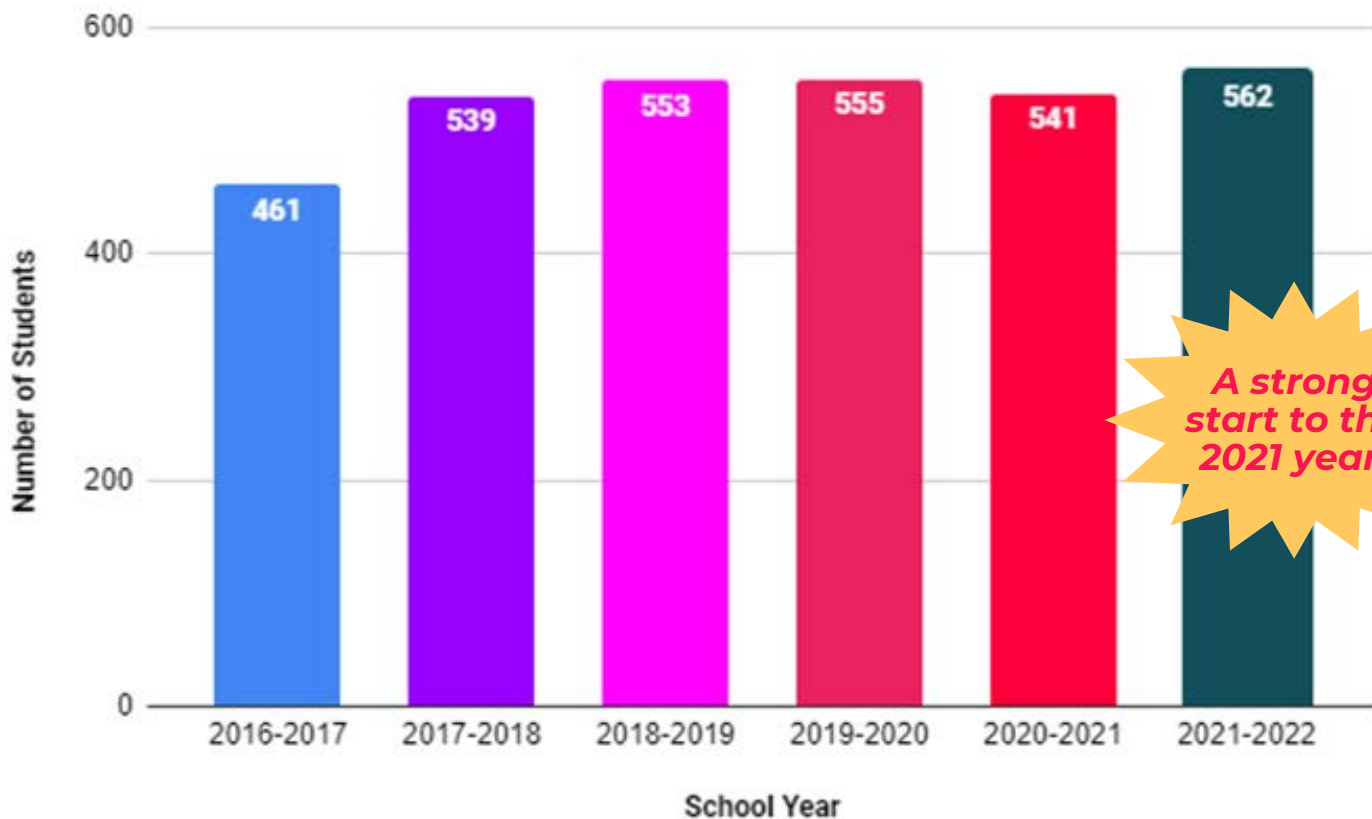

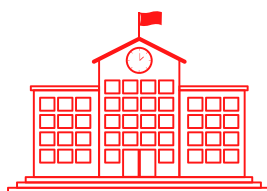


2021 GRADUATES - BY THE NUMBERS

97% received scholarships to Catholic high schools



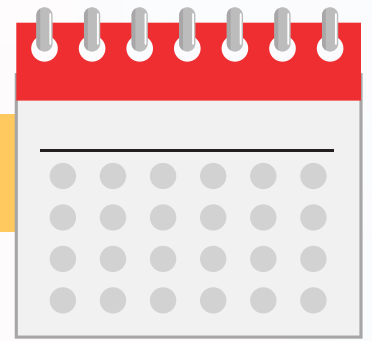

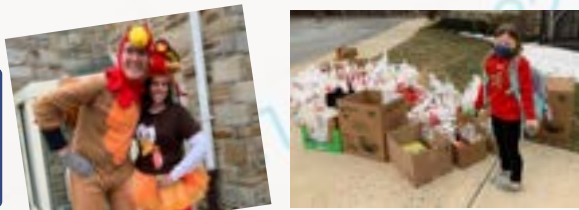
