Dear Parents, Your Help Is Needed

We all pride ourselves in being SJS-Fullerton Families becausewe are all held to our high expectations for our academics, behaviors, words, actions, and uniforms. As we stated at Back to School Night, we are enforcing the uniform policy. Transitioning to our winter uniforms, everyone looked great! There are a few things like shoes and accessories for which we need your assistance.

Shoes: Everyone should be in black tie shoes, as stated on pages 34-36 of our handbook. The girls are allowed to wear Mary Jane style as well. No one is to have any slip-on shoes (unless for a medical reason and we have a doctor's note). Sneakers for P.E. days need to have tie laces as well. This is also stated on page 37 of the handbook. Slip-on sneakers are not as safe for students while participating in P.E. class.

Accessories (pages 35 and 37): For girls, simple hair bows, ribbons, or barrettes; no beads. All hair accessories must be solid, black, white, maroon, or gray. The only exceptions to this are the plaid ones sold by Flynn O'Hara and the Wolfpack headbands sold in HASA's spiritwear store. In addition,

- Small cross or religious medal necklace is permitted
- One pair of small earrings worn in the earlobe (no hoops or dangled, for safety)
- No rings or bracelets, including rubber bracelets
- Scrunchies, hair ties, etc., are not to be worn on the wrist
- No make-up, artificial nails or tips, or nail polish of any color
- No tattoos
- No perfume
- Watches are permitted (no alarms or beeps)
- No Smartwatches
- Undergarments may not show through the uniform

I understand that, in the past, some of these policies may have been overlooked. In our efforts to have everyone on the same page moving forward, I greatly appreciate your support in ensuring that your child arrives each day looking and acting like the SJS-Fullerton student who makes us all proud.






