## From the Principal's Desk

We are off and running here at SJS-Fullerton, and I am so thankful for everyone's dedication on campus that helps support our students each and every day!

### Archbishop Lori Here for Mass

We are blessed to have the Archbishop here on Wednesday, September 20th to celebrate Mass. Students in grades 1-8 will attend Mass with him at 11:30am. We will adjust our schedule internally that day to accommodate Mass in the middle of the day. Please join us at 11:30 if you are available! *We will not be attending the 8:30 Mass that day.*

### Back to School Night Format (9/21 for Grades 1-5 and 9/28 for Grades 6-8)

Everyone begins in the Parish Center (PC) at 6pm for important School, Parish, and HASA information. Parents will be dismissed from the PC to their child's homeroom.

- **Grades 1-3** will host two 20-minute sessions in their classrooms (Mrs. Harman and Mr. McGarrity will be in those classrooms)
- **Grades 4-5** parents will go to their child's homeroom for 5 minutes and then follow their child's Monday schedule, meeting with each teacher for 7 minutes
- **Middle School** parents will go to their child's homeroom for a 5-minute presentation and then will follow their child's Thursday schedule, meeting with each teacher for 7 minutes
- **Special Area** teachers will be in their rooms to meet with parents during their 7-minute time slots (we will let you know which special area teachers are here on which night so you can adjust your schedules)
- **ALL PARENTS** will be asked to review a demographics paper in your child's homeroom
